Designed to enhance dance techniques along with the understanding of the many art forms integrated into a dance performance. Other topics: modern jazz, modern dance, hip hop, ensemble improvisation, make up, costume design, character dance, stories of the great ballets, dance history, mime, acting, auditions, exercises for injury prevention, and nutrition for the dancer. Families and friends are invited to attend a demonstration on Friday, July 10 at 1:15 p.m. where students will share dance techniques they have learned.

Acting Theater Camp for Ages 13 to 18

Headed by Russ Stich, this intensive theater camp is for students who are dedicated to developing their performance skills with experienced professionals. Featuring a focus on the art of comedy, camp participants will alternate between classes (including special workshops) and rehearsals for their performances of *Live From the Beck: Summer Comedy Showcase*, featuring well-known and original scenes and improv sketches and exploring a touch of stand-up comedy. Tickets to the performances are \$5 each.

Broadway: The New Millennium

Musical Theater Camp for Ages 13 to 18

7/27 – 8/14; Mon-Fri; 3 weeks; 12:00 to 4:00 p.m.; Tuition: \$325

Performances on 8/14 & 8/15 at 7:30 p.m.

This musical theater camp is for students who are serious and passionate about performing in musical theater. The camp will focus extensively on musicals that have been created since the turn of this century or have received major revivals during that time. Participants will work with musical directors and choreographers as a dedicated team to pull together the original musical review *Broadway: The New Millennium*. Tickets to the performances are \$5 each.

Audition Date: 7/23, 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. Participants must do a placement audition to determine material for the performance. Sign up slots will be available upon registration. Students are asked to prepare a short musical theater song that they feel best shows off their abilities.
