Learn some popular mixed media techniques and ideas to take your sketchbook / journal to a different level. Emphasis will be on the visual aspect of art journaling. These same techniques can also be applied to Artists Trading Cards. Bring a sketchbook (approx. 8 ½ x 11) and pencil, or pen to first class.
