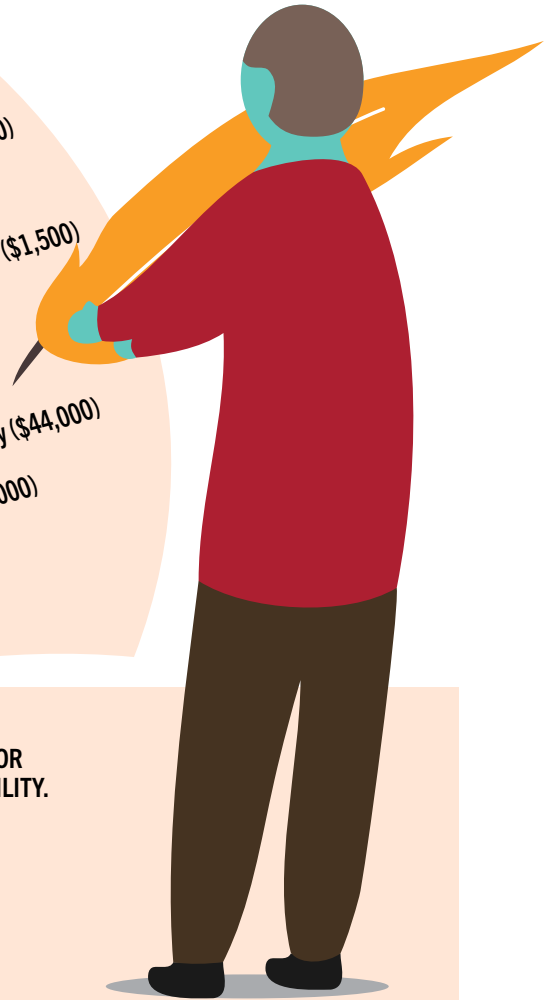
Super Saturday
