### ***Things you should know....***

#### **CLASSES:**

- Be on time and prepared for each class as you will come away with so much more.
- Water is welcome in the classroom – no food or snacks are permitted.
- Cell phone use in classrooms during classes is not permitted by students/parents of all ages.
- Parents with children 6 years of age and younger should remain in the building near the classroom while the class is in session.
- Please be sure to use the restroom facility with your young child immediately prior to the class.
- Parents are welcome to speak with the teachers before/after classes as needed. Many conversations may need to be conducted via phone so as to not take away from the class period and to provide needed privacy.
- Appropriate behavior and attire is expected by all students in the classroom and throughout the arts campus.
- Parents/caregivers are not permitted in the classroom of their child(ren) unless invited in by the teacher. Special days for observation will be announced.

- If you/your child will be absent it is requested that you contact the associate director, listed above, to provide notification that there will be an absence.
- Music studios and creative arts therapies have a separate policy for make-up lessons and absences; students should consult the music office or teacher/creative arts therapist for more details.

- Cancellation of classes will be announced via local TV and radio and through a recorded message at 216.521.2540. Please know that Beck Center rarely closes and does not necessarily close when local schools are closed.


